- We're part of a new initiative to dramatically lower out-of-pocket costs for insulin with Civica—a nonprofit generic pharmaceutical company founded to make quality generic medicines accessible and affordable to everyone.
- Civica will manufacture and distribute insulins at significantly lower prices than insulins currently on the market.

- We're a founding member of CivicaScript, a new Civica Rx subsidiary created to address chronic supply shortages and price fluctuations of critical generic drugs in outpatient settings.
- Highmark is working with fellow leading Blue Cross Blue Shield plans to launch Evio—a new company to curb rising prescription drug costs by improving the drug value chain, tracking the clinical and cost effectiveness of medications, and forming innovative partnerships with manufacturers and other stakeholders.

We hold drug companies accountable for outcomes

- We forged value-based contracts that hold drug companies accountable for the clinical and cost effectiveness of medications. We have contracts for medications that treat chronic, high-cost conditions, including autoimmune diseases, diabetes, COPD and asthma.
- Highmark and Boehringer Ingelheim announced positive results from an outcomes-based agreement, showing that adults with type 2 diabetes and cardiovascular disease who took Jardiance® had a 20% lower annual total cost of care.
- A Highmark-AstraZeneca contract for SYMBICORT® demonstrated positive results in improving patient outcomes for asthma and COPD. We found that the number of patients taking SYMBICORT who saw a worsening of symptoms requiring them to visit a health care provider or hospital were substantially lower than expected.

We take an integrated approach to medical and pharmacy benefits



- Our group customers who combine medical and pharmacy benefits can significantly lower medical costs while also improving health outcomes and member engagement, according to an independent study conducted by HealthScape Advisors.
 Highmark group customers with integrated benefits saved an average of \$150-\$230 permember, per-year.
- In addition to potentially lower medical costs, group customers with integrated medical and pharmacy benefits reduced the average length of inpatient hospital stays by 3.9 percent compared to groups with carved-out pharmacy benefits, and had members who were 14 percent more likely to engage in care management programs.

We care for the whole member

- We're working with Free Market Health to provide quicker access to prescription drugs for Highmark members with complex health conditions, from specialty pharmacies equipped to provide high-quality care management.
- We're utilizing Free Market Health's platform, which matches specialty medication referrals and pharmacies in real time while balancing the cost and value of care.
- Patients are benefitting, demonstrated by a 36 percent reduction in drug abandonment of insurer-authorized referrals. There are potential cost savings, including a ten percent reduction in claims costs for managed oral oncology drugs.
